RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ENTERING INTO A
CONTRACT TO RECYCLE ELECTRONICS
(NO WHITE GOODS – NO FREON ITEMS)

Whereas, the Mayor and Council are desirous of enhancing the Borough's recycling opportunities; and

Whereas, the Borough wishes to enter into a contract with SAMR Services to recycle electronics on a regular basis throughout the year; and

Whereas, SAMR will provide the Borough with a 50 yd. closed container to stage the collected items; and

Whereas, the Borough will pay SAMR \$750 per container from Clean Communities Grant money with a maximum of two exchanges per year; and

Whereas, SAMR will provide the Borough with a certificate of recycling based upon the total weight of the container's contents; and

Whereas, the container will be housed at the Commons and will be available to accept items on the same schedule as the brush schedule, the program is open to High Bridge residents only; and

Whereas, a list of items to be accepted for recycling will be posted at the Commons and at Highbridge.org.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of High Bridge in the County of Hunterdon and in the State of New Jersey hereby approves the entering into a contract with SAMR for the recycling of electronics.
