Whereas, the High Bridge Cultural and Heritage Committee and the High Bridge Historical Society will partner to undertake this initiative; and

Whereas, the High Bridge Cultural and Heritage Committee and the High Bridge Historical Society will partner to carry out repairs and will develop and implement programs for the general public in this initiative; and

Whereas, All volunteers will be required to submit appropriate waivers and all professionals will be required to submit appropriate documentation before beginning work.

Whereas, the High Bridge Cultural and Heritage Committee and the High Bridge Historical Society are aware that use of the areas aforementioned are conditional upon contingent leased access by other potential entities; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of High Bridge in the County of Hunterdon and in the State of New Jersey hereby approves the High Bridge Cultural and Heritage Committee and the High Bridge Historical Society to undertake the aforementioned Solitude House, Associated Buildings and Grounds re-opening initiative.
