REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGH BRIDGE  
Statutory Authorization 75-1

**Whereas**, the Borough of High Bridge as a Municipal appoints a “appropriate authority” to the Chief of Police, and

**Whereas**, Ordinance 75 1 Statutory Authorization states: “A Police Department, as heretofore established, is hereby continued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118. The Mayor and Council is hereby designated as the "appropriate authority" and granted all powers conferred by statute and/or other law upon such appropriate authority, including but not limited to the promulgation, amendment and modification of rules and regulations for the government of the force and for the discipline of its members.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Council of the Borough of High Bridge, Ordinance 75 1 Statutory Authorization is amended to read: “A Police Department, as heretofore established, is hereby continued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118. The Official hereby designated as the "appropriate authority" shall be the Administrator; in the absence of the Administrator, it shall be the Mayor; and in absence of the Administrator and Mayor, the Council President and are granted all powers conferred by statute and/or other law upon such appropriate authority, including but not limited to the promulgation, amendment and modification of rules and regulations for the government of the force and for the discipline of its members.”
