INTERLOCAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENT

NUMBER: 88-2015

ADOPTED: March 26, 2015

WHEREAS, The State of New Jersey requires the Municipality, through its Board of Health, to provide certain public health activities and services in accordance with N.J.S.A. 26:1A-15 and N.J.S.A. 26:3A2-1 et seq., and

WHEREAS, The furnishing of these public health activities and services require the employment of technical and professional personnel, and

WHEREAS, Since most municipalities in Hunterdon County do not have the financial ability to employ on their own accord sufficient professional staff to provide the public health activities and services required by the State of New Jersey, it is apparent that such activities and services can be more efficiently provided on a regional basis, and

WHEREAS, The County is prepared to provide certain public health activities and services to the Municipality through the County Health Department, and

WHEREAS, The Municipality desires to contract with the County for the furnishing of those services to be performed for and on behalf of the Board of Health of the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of High Bridge, in the County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey in consideration of the facts set forth above and the mutual promises, covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement, the parties agree to perform and be responsible to the other as per the attached agreement.
