Event Rules

- Must be 18 or older to enter.
- NEW FORMAT: Painting *en plein air* is to be held from May 30, 2015 - June 6, 2015. Media (paper, boards, canvases, etc.) must be stamped on May 30th to be accepted for the show and eligible for prizes. The show and silent auction will be held outdoors on or near Main Street, High Bridge, NJ from 2-5pm on Saturday, October 3rd with a rain date on October 4, 2015. If there is inclement weather on the 4th, the show will move to a sheltered location.
- The non-refundable registration fee is \$25. Please make checks out to **The Borough of High Bridge**. Indicate "High Bridge Paint Out" on the memo line.
- The following media will be accepted: acrylic, charcoal, oil, pastels, pen and ink, pencil and colored pencil, and watercolors.
- Multiple pieces by each artist will be accepted, however it is the artist's responsibility to provide an easel or display that takes up no more than 4 square feet of floor space to accommodate their work.
- The artwork subject/inspiration must be within the Borough of High Bridge and done on public property unless a private owner gives permission to go on their property. As High Bridge is a gateway to the Ken Lockwood Gorge, this area is also acceptable as subject matter.
- Digital images of the completed artwork must be sent in .jpg format to hbpaintout@yahoo.com no later than June 13, 2015. Also include your name, title of work, medium and starting price as this will be printed in the show booklet. Artwork that is markedly different from the submitted digital image will be disqualified for the awards.
- Cash prizes will be awarded for First (Best in Show), Second and Third places.
- All fees, commissions and sponsorship funds collected by the Borough of High Bridge will be used for other art events and/or art projects.
- The Borough of High Bridge reserves the right to photograph all artists and use images of their artwork; which will be used for advertising and promotion uses only.

Silent Auction Information

- All artists participating in the event must include their artwork in the silent auction. It is recommended that artwork be matted and/or framed.
- Bidding forms will be provided but artists must complete the form including their name, title of work, and media used. Price specified as starting bid price cannot be changed.
- Once artwork is put up for auction, it must remain up for bid until the auction is over.
- Artists are responsible for their artwork while on display at the show.
- All sales will be made through the Borough of High Bridge with a 20% commission on the final bid price. Based upon money collected by the Borough from the purchaser for sold paintings, the Borough shall have no responsibility to pursue the purchaser who submits a check or other funds that are not collectable. Proceeds will be mailed to artists within 30 days of the event.
