**Authorizing The Borough Of High Bridge To Increase The Bid Threshold
And To Appoint A Qualified Purchasing Agent**

ADOPTED: July 16, 2015

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. permits local contracting units to increase their bid threshold up to \$40,000.00; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a permits an increase in the bid threshold if a Qualified Purchasing Agent is appointed as well as granted the authorization to negotiate and award such contracts below the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:34-5, et seq., established the criteria for qualifying as a Qualified Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, John Gregory possesses the designation of Qualified Purchasing Agent as issued by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:34-5, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of High Bridge wishes to increase the bid threshold and to appoint John Gregory as Qualified Purchasing Agent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Borough of High Bridge, County of Hunterdon, New Jersey that the Borough of High Bridge increases its bid threshold to \$40,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of High Bridge hereby appoints John Gregory as the Qualified Purchasing Agent authorized to exercise the duties of a purchasing agent pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(30), with specific relevance to the authority, responsibility, and accountability of the purchasing activity of the contracting unit; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
