## Administrative Order No. 2020-2 Advisement – 4/8/20

In accordance with State Executive Orders No. 107, 108 and 118, as a result of behavior observed in a manner that is inconsistent with and threatens to undermine the social mitigation strategies necessary to limit the spread of COVID-19, creating risks to public health, certain municipal facilities will be closed to the public until further notice as follows:

**Playgrounds and building facilities:** All playgrounds, gazebos, benches, bathrooms and basketball courts located within the municipal parks and open spaces shall be closed to the public.


**Trails:** The Nassau and Springside Trails are closed until further notice.

**Parks and Public Lands:** The Commons lot will be open to permit holders only. Commons Park, Union Forge Park, and Lake Solitude shall remain open for activities as outlined in Executive Order 107 (*walking, running, engaging in outdoor activities with immediate family, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners*). Sedentary activities are prohibited.

**High Bridge Hills Golf Course:** is closed until further notice.


These orders will be strictly enforced to minimize groups being formed and that the public is adhering to social distancing guidelines.
