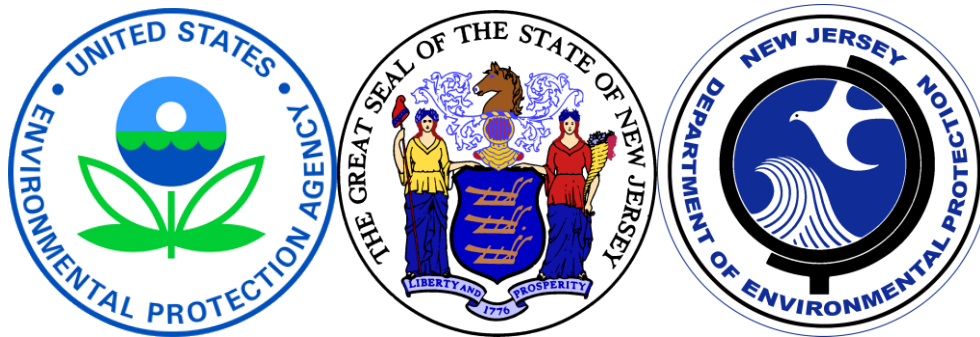


New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program USEPA Public Awareness of SRF Assistance Requirements



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Bunnvale Well Site, which includes construction of site and well improvements for Wells 2, 3, 4, and 5 which includes pump and well head replacements, installation of a new: clear well, electrical building, and auxiliary power unit (generator), piping layout changes, and the removal of: the aeration unit and existing clear well, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The estimated capital cost is \$1,574,060. The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits as the wells currently discharge through above grade piping to the clearwell building. The condition of the clearwell building, roof and frame and the liner has deteriorated. The clearwell is an open top tank which may result in future water quality issues. The clearwell liner has begun to delaminate from the concrete tank causing operational issues. The well site is considered essential infrastructure. The project will benefit residents and businesses in the Borough of High Bridge, Hunterdon County, New Jersey.
